### 7. Explanation of the Change:

This reflects the elimination of the IGR requirements. CSC 105 and CSC 150 are being moved into the major core requirements. EPSY 210 was also required as an IGR so this course is specified as a choice in the general education selections. ECON 201 is being moved from general education requirement to the core. SEED 420 is being added to the professional education core requirements. Electives remain the same.
